Future of the South-eastern Europe Health Network in the framework of the South East European Co-operation Process (2008 and beyond)

> Banja Luka, Bosnia and Herzegovina, 12 October 2011

The Ministries of Health of the Republic of Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina¹, the Republic of Bulgaria, the Republic of Croatia, the Republic of Macedonia, the Republic of Moldova, Montenegro, the Republic of Romania, and the Republic of Serbia (hereinafter: founder member states of the South-eastern Europe (SEE) Health (Network).

Realling that the SEE Health Network has been operational for the past ten years developing regional cooperation and technical activities in public health in SEE; this regional cooperation in public health was formalized with the consensual commitment of the ministers of health of the SEE. Health Network founder's member states to the provisions of the Dubrownik and Skopje Pfedges, endorsed at the First Health Ministers' Forum in 2001 and the Second Health Ministers' Forum in 2001 and the

Recalling that regional cooperation in public health remains of the highest priority in underpinning political cooperation and economic development in the SEE region, in facilitating confidence-building, and as a supporting instrument for European and Euro-Atlantic integration process,

Recognising that the founder member states of the SEE Health Network have personally entered into the Memorandum of Understanding on the Fature of the South-eastern Europe Health Network in the Framework of the South East European Co-operation Process signed on 20 April 2009 (Dereinafter: the Memorandum), and the Agreement among the Member States of the South-eastern Europe Health Network on the Host Country Arrangements on The Sear of the Secretaria of South-eastern Europe Health Network signed on 90 November 100 Novem

Recognizing contemporary changes and new developments requiring the SEE Health Network to adapt to the new realities, namely:

- the Regional Cooperation Council; Memorandum of Understanding was signed between the South-eastern Europe Health Network and the Regional Cooperation Council in 2010 to frame, forward and partner regional cooperation in health in SEE with political, economic and other health related initiatives in the SEE region, and
- The two of the founder member states of the SEE Health Network (Bulgaria and Romania), having become members of the European Union. European Union, have supported SEE Health Network, emphasizing public health as a tool for economic and human development.

Recognizing the need and desire of constant adaptation to contemporary needs and interests to enhance and enrich alliance in public health in the SEE, that requires setting up legal grounds for enlargement of the SEE Health Network with new member states beyond the founder member states of the SEE Health Network and

Amendments to the Memorandum of Understanding

In accordance with the Article XII of the Memorandum.

HAVE AGREED TO AMEND THE MEMORANDUM AS FOLLOWS:

Article I

The text in the Memorandum that reads as "member country" or "member countries" or "SEE

members' or "SEE member' or "country" with the meaning of the SEE Health Network' member state, shall be replaced with the text "member state of the SEE Health Network" or "member states of the SEE Health Network" accordingly.

Article II

The following shall be added at the end of Article IV, Paragraph 1:

New parties may join the SEE Health Network and become member states with the unanimous approval of the member states of the SEE Health Network, upon accepting the relevant decisions and stantes of the SEE Health Network, as well as the Agreement among the Nember States of the South-eastern Europe Health Network on the Host Country Arrangements on The Seat of the Secretariat of South-eastern Europe Health Network signed in 2010, and after approval by the SEE Health Network, as prescribed by the Memorandum

Article IV, Paragraph 2 is amended and shall read as follows:

2. The SEE Health Network will seek collaboration with other countries recognized by the United Nations, as well as with international and regional governmental and nongerous-memental and miscontinuous and integration organizations of the contribution of the state of partners of the purpose of the partners of the partn

Article III

Article VI paragraph 2 and paragraph 3 of the Memorandum are amended and shall read as follows:

- 2 The Regional Meeting of the SEE Health Network shall comprise on high-level representative, hereinster referred to as the National Health Coordinator and one alternate nominated by the ministry of health of each country, whether member state of the SEE Health Network or a partner country and shall be opened to one representative from each partner where the state of the decision-refluencing professionals at the level of at least sentor policy making person from the respective minister of health, designated by the respective minister of health.
- 3. The Executive Committee shall be composed of five members: three representing the

member states of the SEE Health Network, one representing the partner states and one member jointy nominated by interestate international and regional governmental nongovernmental and integration organizations. Article IV

The SEE Health Network Secretariat shall receive contributions from the member states of the SEE Health Network.
